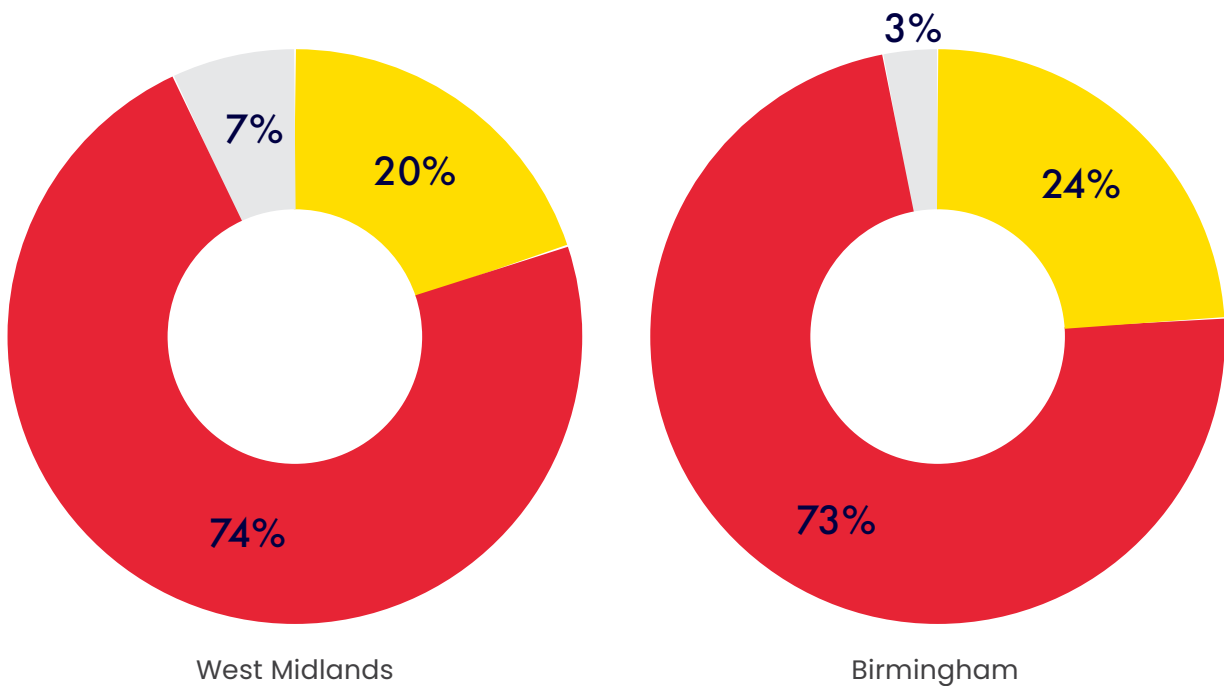

Which of the following statements best reflects your situation?

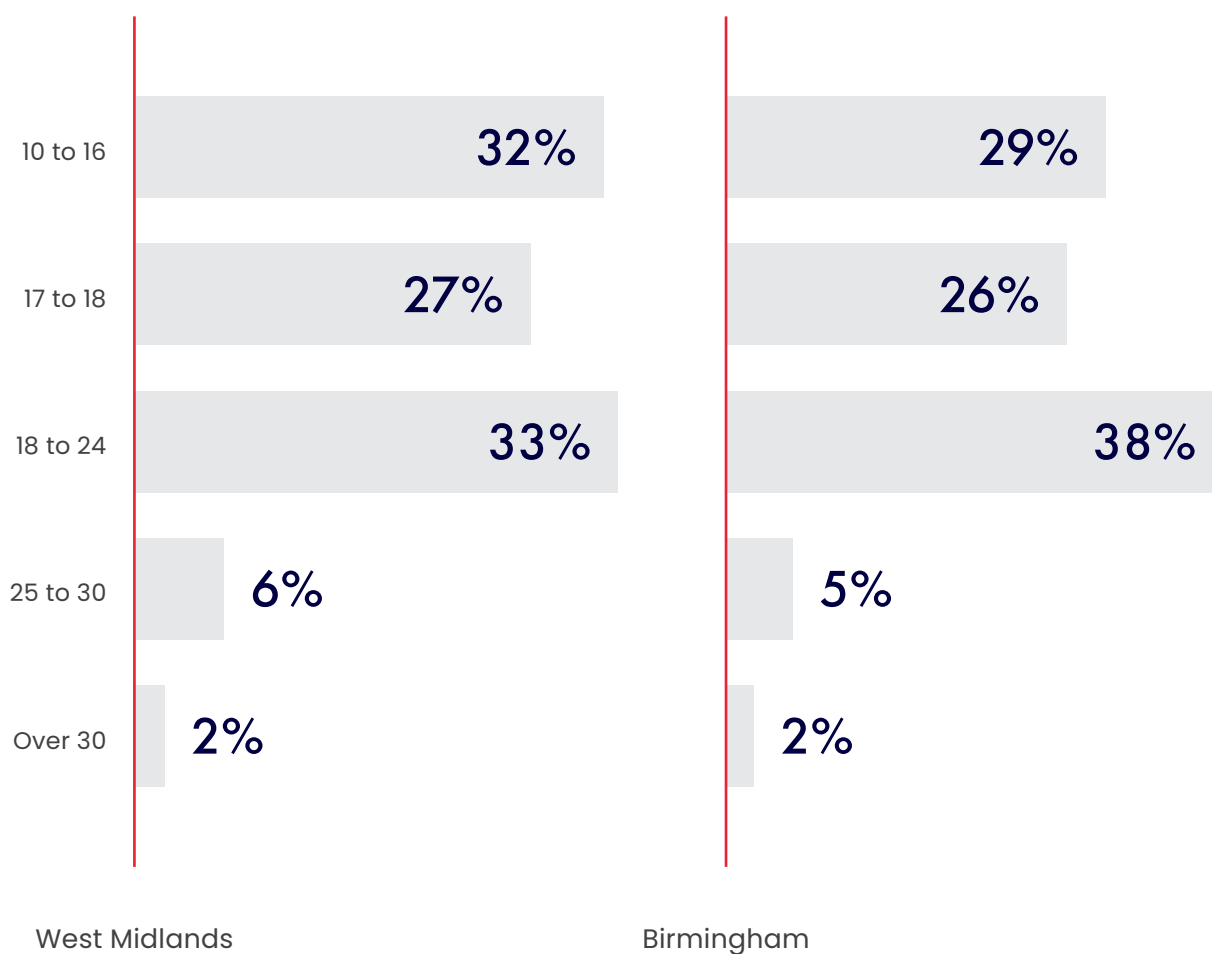

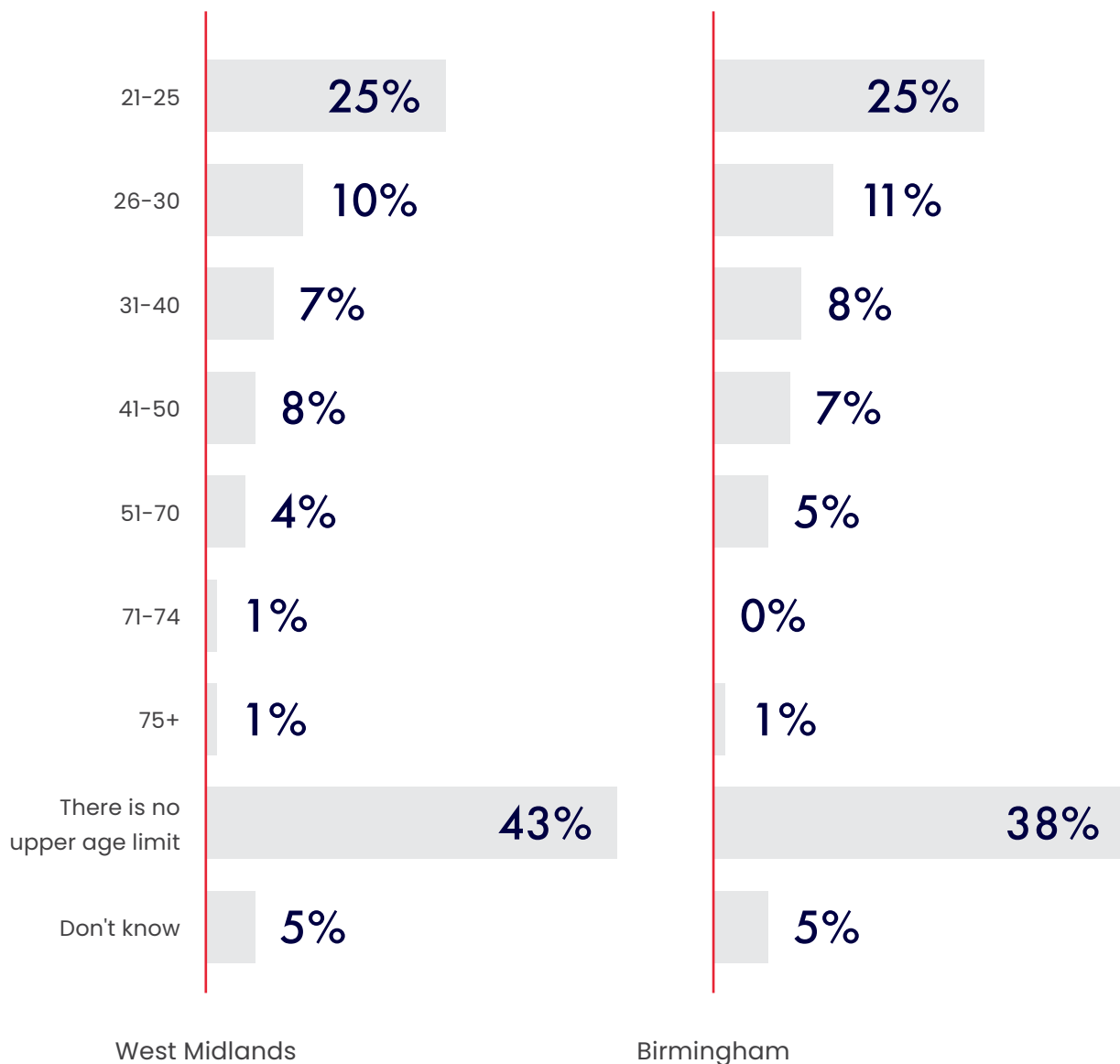
What was your age when you left formal education (either full-time or part-time)?

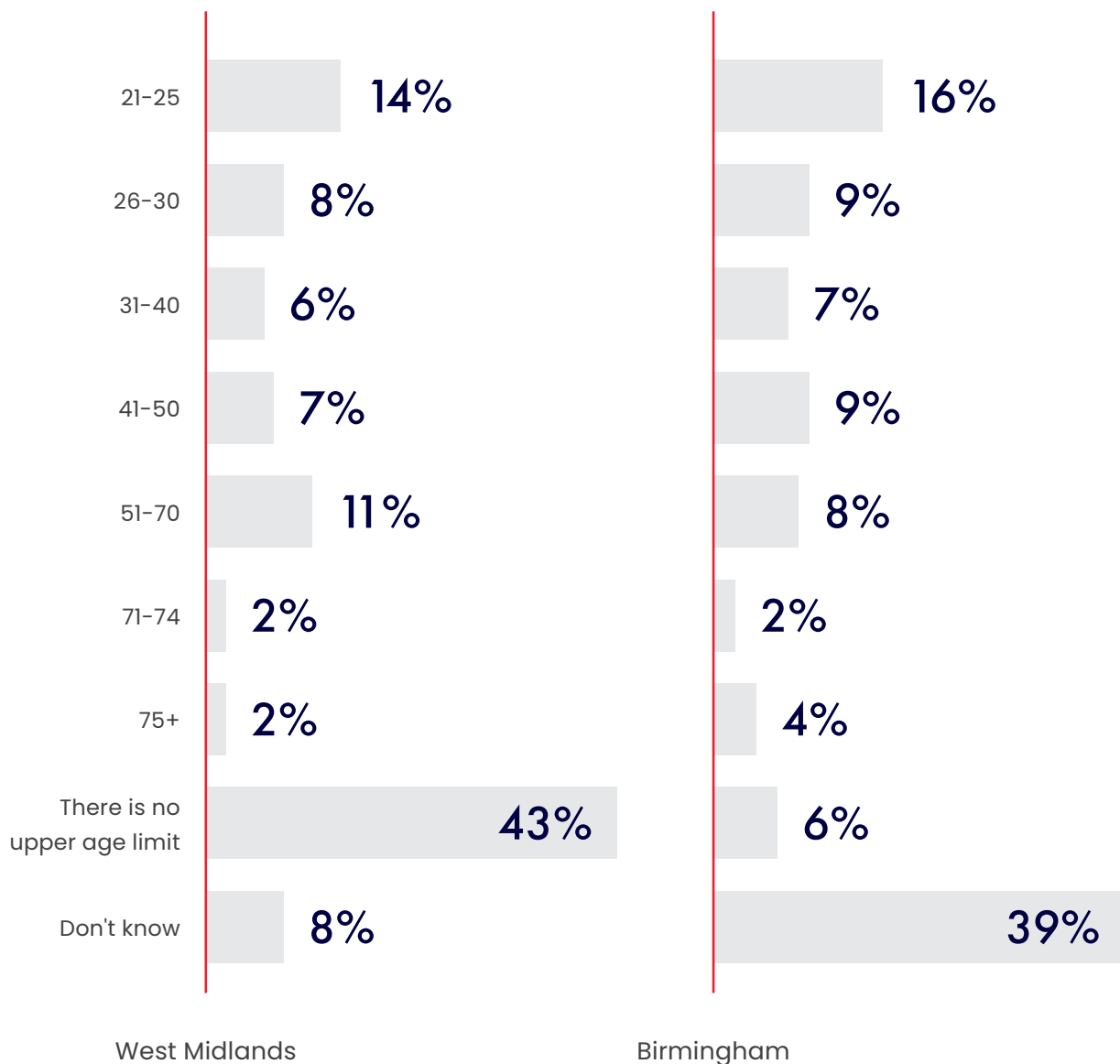
What do you believe is the upper age limit for being able to attend formal education (such as University) in the UK?

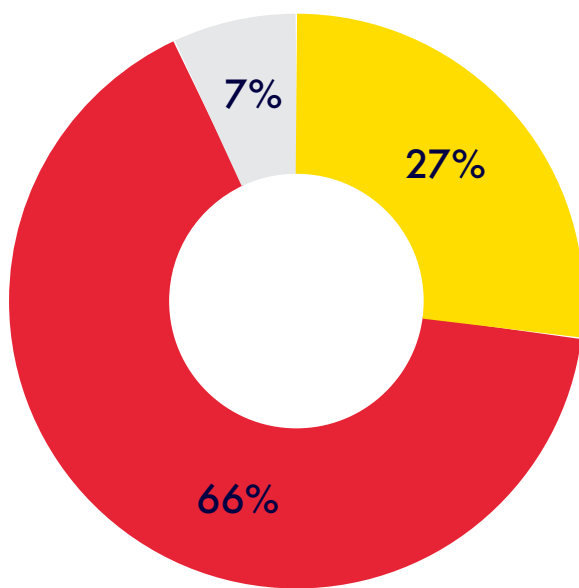
What do you believe is the upper age limit for being able to attend work-related training/retraining in the UK?



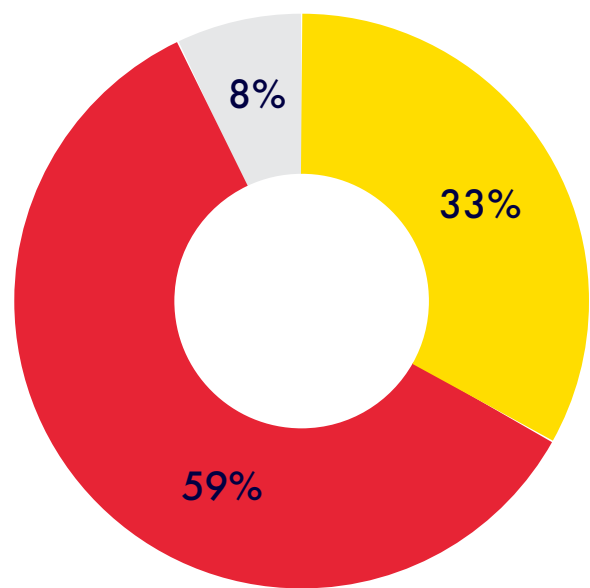

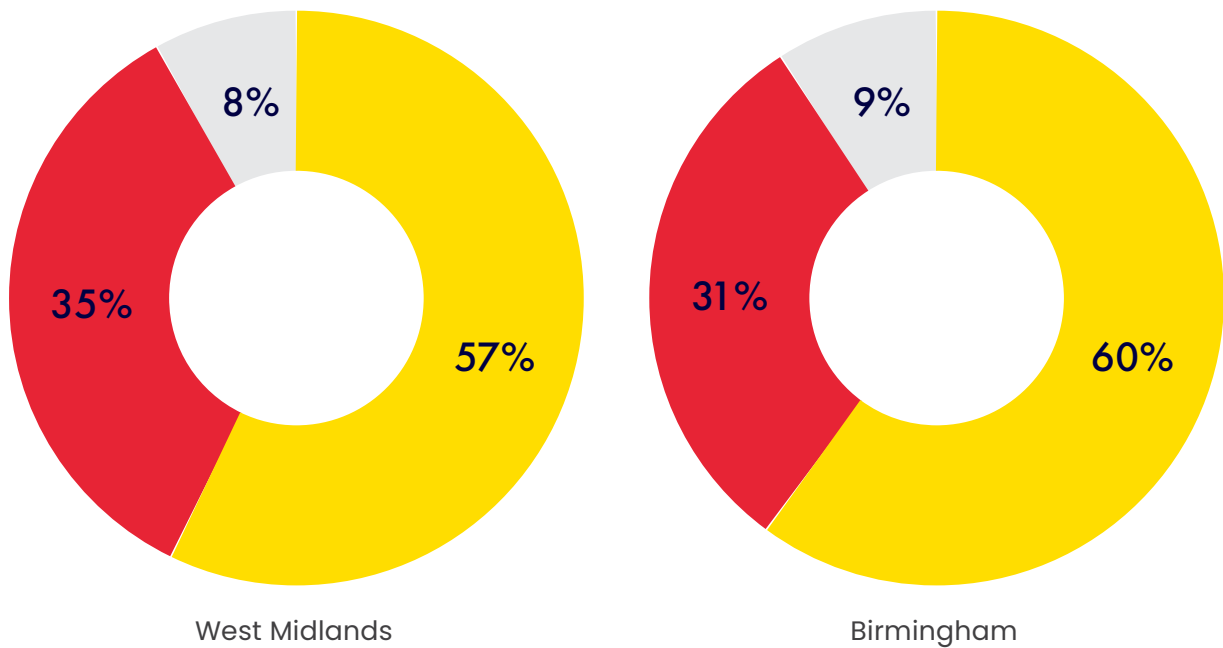

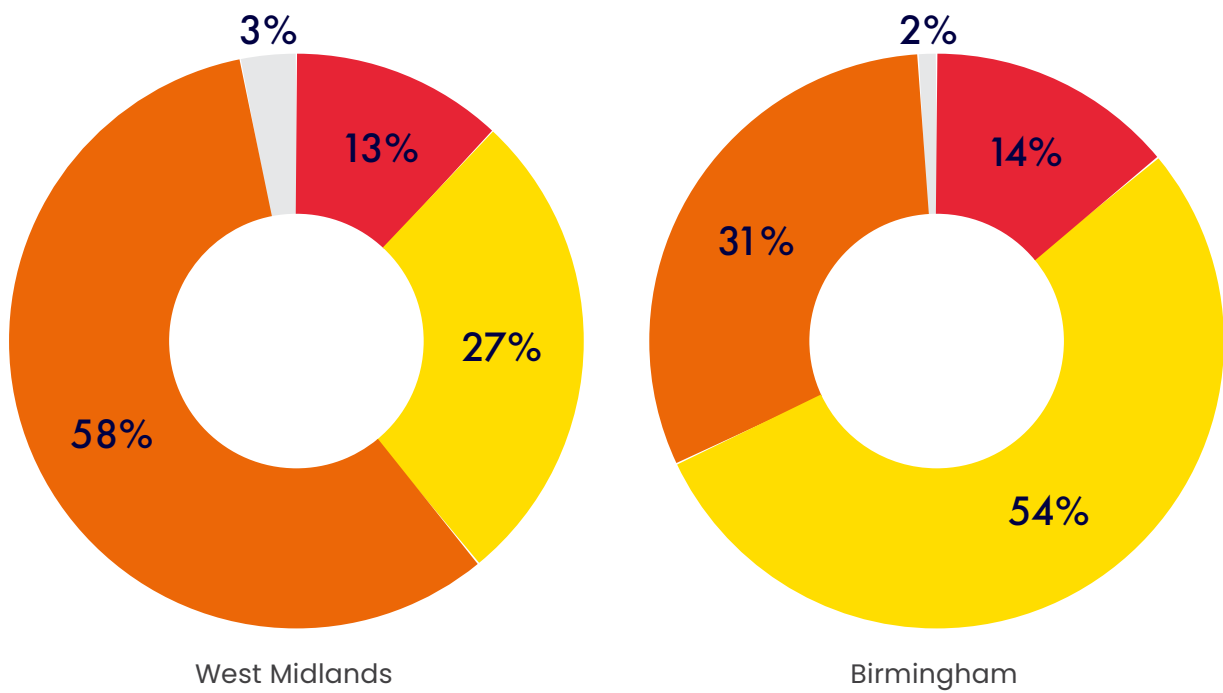

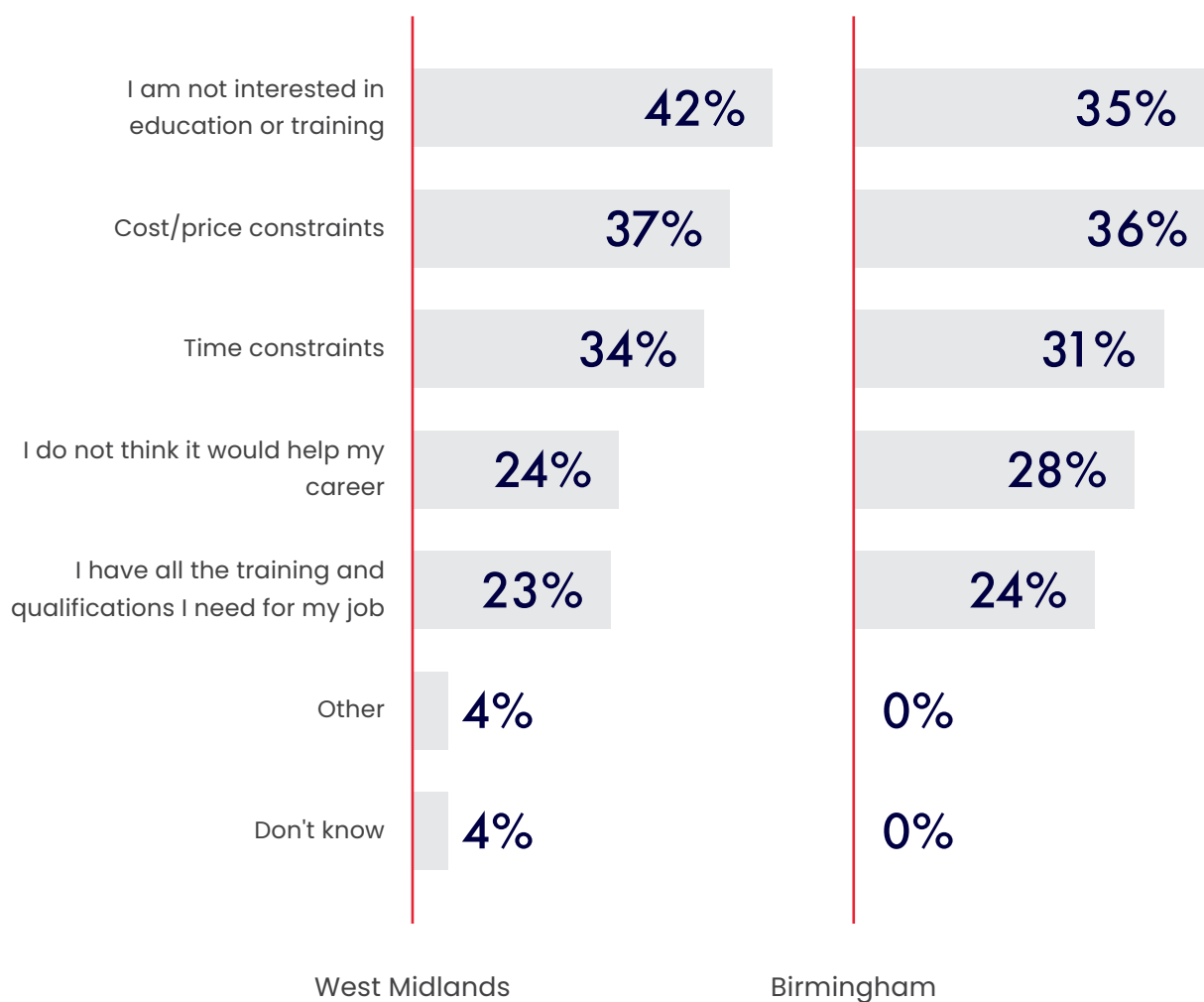

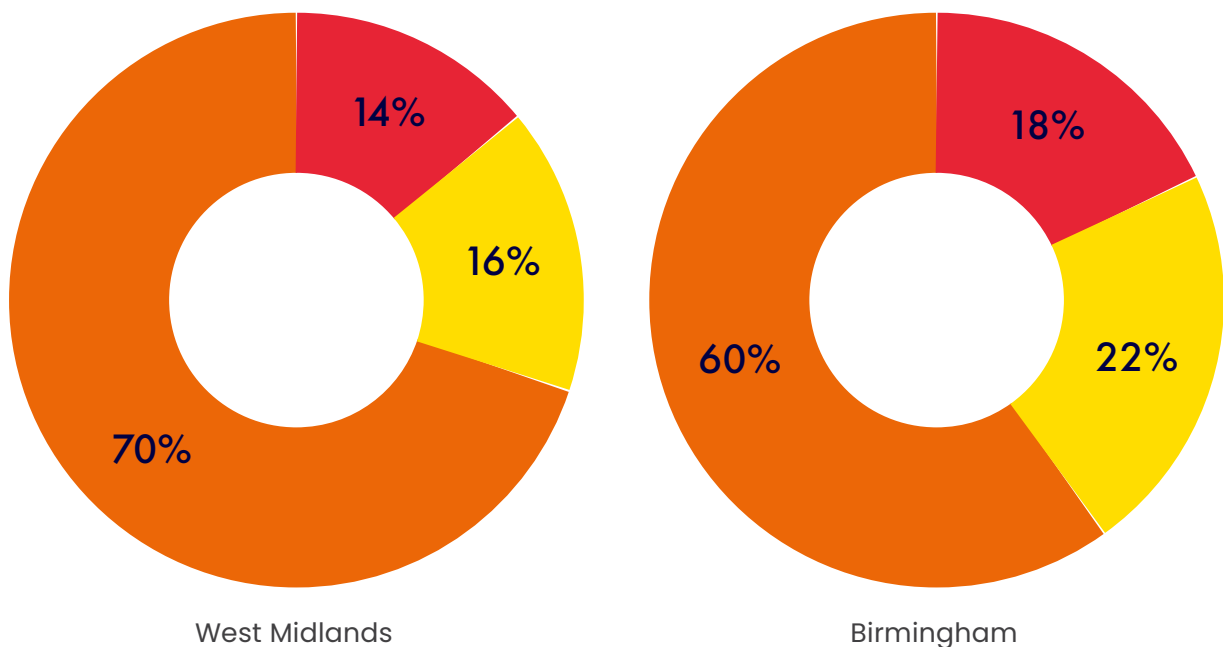
What are the barriers to you enrolling in education or training?

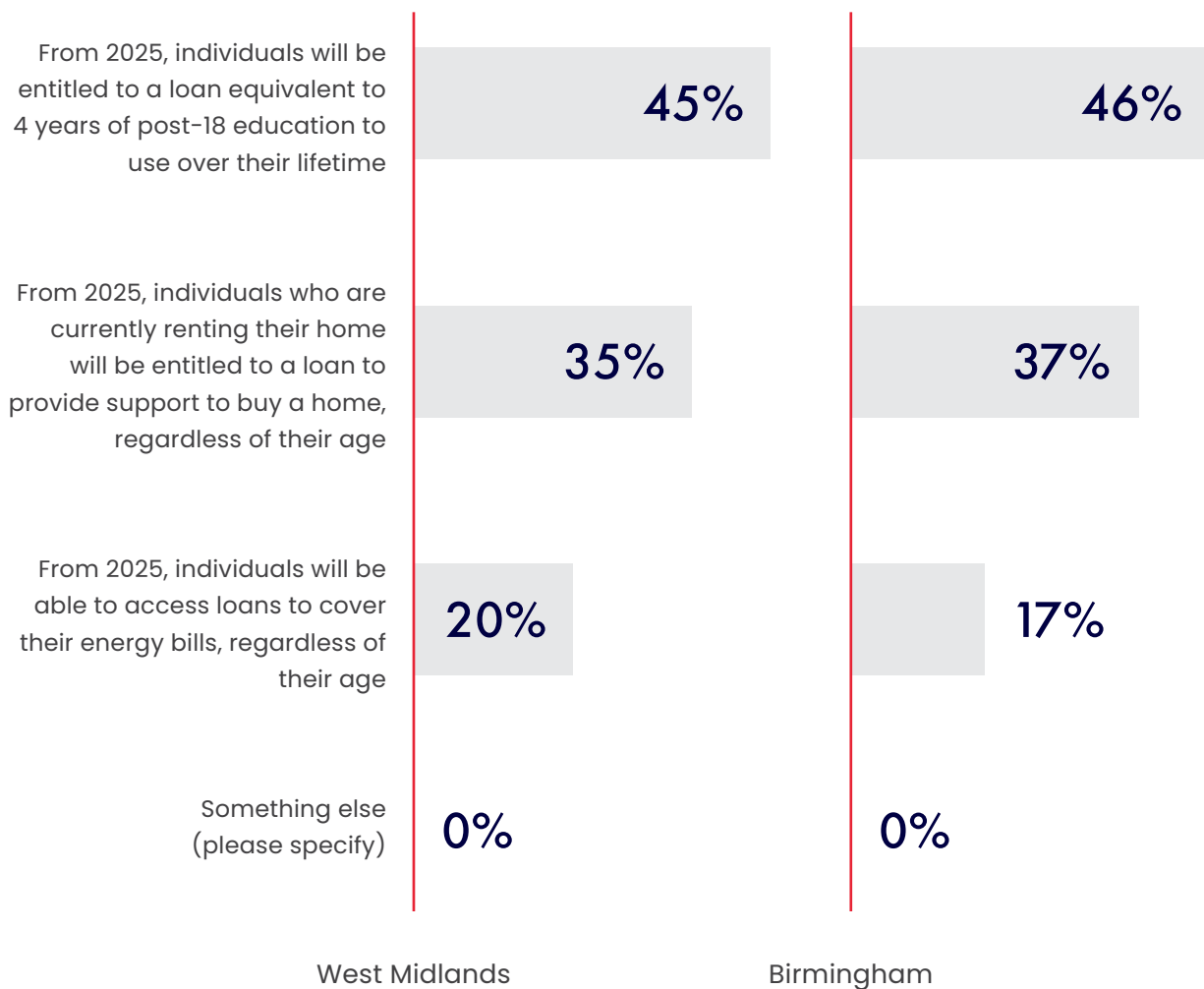
